Health Fair 3/23 for 6th grade

The Health Fair allows all our sixth graders to take their knowledge from health and expand on it with the help from nursing students in the Molloy College program. Some of the stations the students experienced were personal hygiene, cyberbullying, vaping, stress and anxiety, drugs and alcohol, and sleep deprivation and technology. In groups, students got to work with the nursing program students on interactive examples and discussions.

6th grade students

6th grade science students will be participating in the I am EM-Powered Challenge- A Celebration of Earth Month- sponsored by PSEG Long Island. This project will focus on creating awareness about energy, prompting energy efficiency, and the diverse ways to help save and protect the environment. Students will be discovering important concepts about environmental issues that face our world today. Through their guided research, students will choose a topic of interest and become experts on that topic. In English class, students will learn about Public Service Announcements (PSAs) and the importance of these announcements in educating people. As a culminating activity, students will work in teams to create a Public Service Announcement video based on their research to inspire others to make a positive change in the world. Finally, the top three videos will be entered in the contest. Entries from across Suffolk, Nassau, and the Rockaways will be judged, and the top ten videos will be chosen as the winners.
