Dear Parents:

We are looking forward to our Winter Concert. You are cordially invited to attend the Marion Street Winter Concert on Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the Lynbrook High School gymnasium. Our Grade 4 and 5 students and staff have been preparing for this performance and we appreciate your support of our music program. You can further help us by reviewing these concert procedures with your child:

- All Grade 4 and 5 students performing in the concert should enter through the **MAIN Entrance on UNION Ave** at **6:00 p.m.** Please do NOT drop your child off earlier than 6:00 p.m.
- Guests will need to enter at the rear of the building and use the gymnasium doors on **CARPENTER Ave. Gym doors will open at 6:30 pm for guests.**
- Students will take their belongings (coats, instruments, music folders, etc.) to the following assigned supervised locations:
  - Orchestra: Orchestra Room
  - Chorus Students: Cafeteria
  - Concert Band/Wind Ensemble: Cafeteria
- Concert Dress Attire is to be worn to *both* the daytime performance at Marion Street (**WEDNESDAY, December 11<sup>th</sup> @ 9:30 a.m.**) and the evening performance at the High School. **Dress attire** includes: bright *white collared long-sleeved button-down shirts tucked into pants, Marion Street Vest, black pants, dark socks and closed toe black shoes.* Marion Street Vests will be collected at the end of the concert.
- All students will return to the large gymnasium at the end of the concert to meet their parents. Audience members should remain in the gymnasium and wait for their child at the end of the performance.

On behalf of the students and staff, we look forward to a wonderful performance and to seeing you Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at Lynbrook High School. Thank you for your cooperation.

# Concert Dress Uniform Requirements

Winter, Spring & Select Concerts [revised 2024]

The Lynbrook Union Free School District greatly values our exceptional performing arts programs. Our musical student “teams” work tirelessly to present a professional concert experience, from the high-quality music to our own musical uniforms.

## HIGH SCHOOL & MIDDLE SCHOOLS

### Band, Orchestra, Chorus

#### Choice #1

- Black pants/slacks
- Bright white blouse with discreet neckline
- Black dress shoes w/moderate heel or flats (*no boots or sneakers please*) and black socks/stockings

#### Choice #2

- Black pants/slacks
- Bright white collared long sleeved *full* button-down dress shirt - tucked into pants
- Long solid black tie (*no bold patterns/designs*)
- Black socks, black dress shoes (*no boots or sneakers please*), black belt

### Concert Choir (LHS)

Same as above except for the following :

Black blouse (*long or short sleeved with discreet neckline*) or Black long sleeve button down dress shirt w/tie (*color tbd*)

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

### Band, Orchestra, Chorus

#### Black pants/slacks

Bright white collared blouse or long sleeved full button-down dress shirt – both tucked into pants.  
*Entirely* black shoe (including any visible sole/detail) w/low heel or flats (*no boots or sneakers*) and black socks/stockings  
School issued vest/tie (*if supplied*)

## SELECT/SPECIAL ENSEMBLES

*Dress requirements to be determined by Ensemble Director*

### The following are not be permitted on stage

- t-shirts or tank tops
- jeans
- sleeveless or off the shoulder blouses; rolled up sleeves
- white/sport socks or sport shoes
- excessive hair ornaments or jewelry
- sheer, lace, or mesh clothing
- sneakers/boots/sandals/flip-flops etc.

#### Please Note:

- Students not adhering to the dress requirements may not be permitted to perform.
- Elementary students are to wear this concert dress for the daytime *assembly* concert.
- These dress requirements do not include Junior Concerts.
- Friends of Lynbrook Music provides recycled concert clothing available for your convenience. Please inquire with your student’s music teacher.
